## RHUM AGRICOLE

Rhum Agricole was invented sometime in the mid 19th century in the West Indies country of Martinique. When the island nation's refined sugar market collapsed due to cheap competition from South America, a substitute to traditional rum was required. Rhum Agricole is made differently than Rum which is traditionally made by distilling fermented molasses. For Rhum, the cane is cut and crushed and the juice sluiced directly into fermenters and eventually heads to a still for distillation.

Rhum Agricole is made from sugar cane which essentially is a tall grass. When freshly pressed it has a faint aroma of a recently cut lawn. It's aromatics have often been described as earthy, vegetal, grassy and herbal; some also have an overlying fruitiness that resembles banana, pineapple mango and papaya. Barrel aging Rhum matures the flavour profile to yield butterscotch notes which is more prevalent in molasses based rums. Further barrel aging Rhum to eight or ten years might make it difficult to distinguish between aged Rhum Agricole and an aged molasses-based rum.

## ARMAGNAC

At their closest points the french regions of Cognac and Armagnac are only 128 kilometres apart, but as brandies they are a world apart. Cognac requires a double distillation compared to the traditional single distillation of Armagnac which gives the final pre aged spirit more flavour and character than Cognac. It is this and the use of different barrels over a long period of time that gives Armagnac such distinction.

Created from just a few principal grapes, Armagnac falls into the brandy family of spirits and is the oldest produced in France. Many houses will distill the different grapes separately and then blend after barrel-aging has occurred. Some houses don't even own their own still and have to wait on the availability of the local still. The craft and artisanal heritage focuses on tradition, long running family houses where secrets are passed from father to son or in many cases to daughter. It is strictly governed by appellation regulations of the Armagnac region, Bas-Armagnac being the most premier.



## DELORD

Situated in Bas-Armagnac, Delord's distillery is found in the village of Lannepax, the ancestral home of the Delord family. Their cellars include more than 1000 barrels and a dozen oak tanks that protect and age the Armagnac eau-de-vie dating from the 20th Century to the present day. The oldest vintages are kept in Bonbonnes (glass jars) away from the light in a room called Paradise. Their Armagnac is made from Ugni Blanc, Folle Blanche, Baco and Colombard. The four varieties are harvested, pressed and vinified separately in a winemaking cellar a few meters from the distillery.

## COGNAC

Specifically made within the Cognac region of France, there are 6 different terroirs; the most premium being Grand Champagne and Petit Champagne. A blend of the 2 being able to be labelled as 'Fine Champagne' signifying the most premium growing land.

The primary grape used to make Cognac is Ugni Blanc though smaller amounts of Folle Blanche and Colombard are used. In contrast to French wine, Cognac is still known by its brands, rather than individual producers or estates. The four biggest houses, Hennessy, Courvoisier, Rémy Martin and Martell are global entities whose share in 90% of the cognac market.

The minimum aging required to be classified as a Cognac is 2 years which is referred to as a V.S or Very Special. V.S.O.P. or Very Superior Old Pale is the next tier requiring a minimum of 4 years aging. Lastly Extra Old, or X.O. has a minimum ageing requirement of 10 years but many XO blends on the market today contain eaux-de-vie well exceeding this 10 year age limit.



## HENNESSY

Founded in 1765 by Richard Hennessy, an Irish officer serving in the army of King Louis XV of France, the distillery today is still owned and run by the 8th generation of the Hennessy family.

All the grapes are harvested from vineyards in four crus - Grande and Petite Champagne, Borderies and Fin Bois, surrounding the river Charente. The company has one of the largest reserves of Cognac in its cellars - there are more than 300,000 casks, of which many are more than 100 years old, and some as much as 200. Hennessy also introduced the star rating system in the 1860s and the first XO Cognac in 1870.

## JEAN FILLIOUX GRANDE CHAMPAGNE COGNAC

Founded in 1880 by Honoré Fillioux, the company is now run by his great-grandson Pascal J. Fillioux. The vineyards lie in the heart of the Grande Champagne in the 'golden triangle': Verrières, Angeac-Champagne and Juillac-le-Coq. It is well known that this area yields the most delicate and finest Cognacs, and requires long oak barrel ageing to achieve maturity: the ageing is the key.

The men in the Fillioux dynasty have each borne a great love to their region and their soil. Over several decades by producing consistently authentic Cognacs that rest on century-old traditions, patience and love to become the masterpieces true connoisseurs appreciate.
